The Position

As a Confined Space Inspector, you will:

- Report to the Manager of Engineering and Structures;
- Coordinate work activities with Project Coordinators, CAD Designers, the Project Administrator, and Project Engineers;
- Perform the duties of confined space “entrant” or “attendant” as will be defined in the provided training and certification, in compliance with applicable confined space legislation. Some of the duties (not all and not in any particular order) are;
 - Set up traffic control requirements
 - Set up the tripod / winch / cable / harness rescue equipment
 - Obtain confined space opening and closing numbers
 - Complete Confined Space Entry form / paperwork
 - Pump water from the confined space
 - Obtain gas detector readings
 - Obtain surface pictures in N / S / E / W directions as well as looking down. Note any defects
 - Obtain internal pictures of N / S / E / W walls, roof and ceiling. Note any defects
 - Record internal dimensions of the confined space, as well as other data indicated on the Inspection Summary chart
 - Observe and record the location, depth, length and width of any cracks or damages in the concrete

- Identify the location of all duct entrances to the confined space, and note the duct occupancy
- Provide cable / splice racking diagrams when requested by the client
- Ongoing development of Planview's design standards and methodologies to further develop design and operational efficiencies;
- Interface directly with Planview clients and other third party resources to discuss, review and provide consultations for project requirements;
- Attend site meetings with clients or third parties as required;
- Adhere to strict project budgets and client deliverable dates;
- Other activities as assigned by supervisor, such as CAD and GIS support for example.

- Physically fit.
- Enjoy working outside, even in poor weather conditions.
- Strong problem solving and troubleshooting skills
- Excellent written and oral communication skills
- The ability to deal with multiple projects and conflicting deadlines
